

Ms. Eirini Nikolaidi is the General Counsel and Chief Officer for Legal & Regulatory Affairs of OTE Group (both fixed (OTE S.A.) and mobile (COSMOTE S.A.)) and joined the Group in 1996.

Ms. Nikolaidi is a member of the Management Board of OTE Group, member of the Board of Directors of OTE's subsidiary in Romania and member of the Supervisory Board and the Audit Committee of the Deutsche Telekom AG subsidiary in Croatia, Hrvatski Telekom d.d.

She holds a law degree from the University of Athens, as well as a master's degree (LLM) in International Business Law from the University of London (UCL), where she specialized, among others, in international finance and international trade law.

She is a telecommunications expert and member of the Athens Bar Association.

Mr. Ivica Mišetić, Ph.D., graduated from the Faculty of Economics and Business of the University of Zagreb in 1983. He earned his Masters' degree with the thesis "Marketing in Travel Agencies" and his Doctor's Degree with the dissertation "Air Carrier Marketing Management".

Mr. Mišetić started his career as Regional Sales Manager of Slovenian air carrier Adria Airways, where he was employed from 1985 to 1991. He then moved to Croatia Airlines in March 1991 as one of the founders of the Croatian carrier and was promoted to Senior Vice President for Marketing and Sales the following year.

In early 1995, Mr. Mišetić was appointed Head of State Protocol for the Republic of Croatia and Ambassador, simultaneously holding Ambassador status. Upon his return to Croatia Airlines in 1997 he took the position of Chief Executive Officer.

Under the leadership of Mr. Mišetić, Croatia Airlines became one of the first airlines to fulfill the requirements of the IATA Operational Safety Audit (IOSA). Mr. Mišetić also initiated the modernization of the fleet and took the airline into the Star Alliance in 2004. As a result, Croatia Airlines is now a leading airline in the region.

Since 2002 until 2010, Mr. Mišetić has been a Member of the Presidents' Committee of the Association of European Airlines (AEA). and in 2009, he became Chairman of the AEA and Member of the IATA Nominating Committee. He was also a Council Member of the Croatian Tourist Board in the period from 1997 until 2012.

In October 2010, he joined Atlantic Grupa d.d. as General Secretary, at the time of the acquisition of Droga Kolinska. In 2010, Mr. Mišetić was also elected Lecturer at the University of Zagreb. In November 2011, he was appointed, for the second time, to the National Council for Higher Education.

Mr. Mišetić has received several decorations from the Republic of Croatia for his contribution and achievements and has been awarded the French Legion of Honor Medal.

Gordan Gledec is the Dean of Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Computing, University of Zagreb (UNIZG-FER) and Full Professor at the Department of Applied Computing. From 1997 to 2005 he was working at the UNIZG-FER's Department of Telecommunications.

His scientific and professional interests include Internet and World Wide Web technologies, Internet security, web usability, human computer interaction and natural language processing. He teaches several courses on undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate doctoral and specialist study programmes (*Regulation of Electronic Communications Market and Information Security*).

He is an author of a chapter in the handbook „Basics of Network Architecture“ (2003) and an editor and co-author of chapters in the handbook „Telecommunications – technology and market“ (2007). He is co-author of the chapter „Spellchecker“ in Wiley Encyclopaedia of Computer Science and Engineering.

He mentored more than 120 student theses on all levels of study. He published more than 40 conference and journal papers at international conferences and in journals. He was a researcher on more than 10 national and international scientific projects and projects with industry partners.

He is a member of Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE) and member of Communications Society and Computer Society.

At UNIZG-FER he was chairman of the Quality Assurance Committee (2010-2014) and Vice Dean for Research (2014-2018). In 2011-2013 he was a member of the Working Group for Information Strategy of the University of Zagreb and in 2013 he was a member of the Working Group for University of Zagreb's Quality Assurance Strategy. Since 2014 he is a member of the Technical Area Board at the University of Zagreb and since October 2018 he is a member of the University Senate.

Since 2004 he is a member and since 2011 chairman of the Committee for Management of National TLD .hr., a professional body of Croatian Academic and Research Network (CARNET).

He is a member of the Croatian Genealogical Society “Pavao Ritter Vitezović”. He is co-author of a book “Facing the Mystery of a Family Tree” (chapter “Computers and Genealogy”).
